AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 279 "PARKS & RECREATION AREAS" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEANPORT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VETERANS FIELD

WHEREAS, the Borough continues to evaluate the Borough's parks and recreation areas in order to promote and maximize the use of all facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's municipal complex consisting of <u>15+</u> acres has a large open space adjacent to the municipal building and ending at Razor Avenue that the Governing Body desires to designate a portion of as Veterans Field,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Oceanport, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that the following sections of Chapter 279 "Parks and Recreation Areas" be amended as follows:

Chapter 279 Parks and Recreation Areas

§ 279-1. Definitions.

PARK, FIELD, COURT, PLAYGROUND, FACILITY or PARK PROPERTY -

- A. Blackberry Bay Park;
- B. Maria Gatta Park
- C. Sommers Park
- D. Trinity Park
- E. Charles Park
- F. Evergreen Park
- G. Old Wharf Park
- H. Mike MacStudy Sr. Field
- I. Community Center Park
- J. Veterans Field
- K. Any other park, reservation, playground, recreation center or any other area in the Borough owned or used by the Borough and devoted to active or passive recreation.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this article are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED this amending ordinance shall become effective upon due passage and publication according to law.
