**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-6**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$440,574.00  
TO BE USED FOR THE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO LIBERTY FIRE STATION WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF  
PENNS GROVE, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to authorize the Infrastructure Improvements to Liberty Fire Station within the Borough of Penns Grove: and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available for said purpose from the State of New Jersey Small Cities Community Development Block Grant and the Borough's Capital Improvement Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Penns Grove, County of Salem and State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated from the following sources the sum of \$440,574.00 to be used for the following capital project within the Borough of Penns Grove:

<u>Purpose/Improvement</u>	<u>Estimated Total Cost</u>	<u>Capital Improvement Fund</u>	<u>Small Cities CDBG Grant</u>
A. Infrastructure Improvements to Liberty Fire Station	\$440,574.00	\$40,574.00	\$400,000.00

SECTION 2: In connection with the amounts authorized in Section 1, the Borough makes the following determinations:

- a) The purpose described in Section 1 is not a Current Expense and is an improvement, which the Borough may lawfully make as a general improvement.
- b) The period of usefulness of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof is twenty (20) years or more.
- c) No debt is authorized by this ordinance.
- d) The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and available for inspection.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage, publication in accordance with law and after final adoption as provided by law.




