

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 640.020 OF THE CITY OF PEVELY MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO THE CONTENTS OF APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES FOR CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Pevely, Missouri wish to increase the application fee for licenses for contractors and subcontractors; and

WHEREAS, the fee for review and implementation of contractor and subcontractor license applications has not been modified since 2012; and

WHEREAS, the cost for review has increased as the cost of living and salaries and benefits for staff have increased; and

WHEREAS, the Pevely Planning & Zoning Commission has reviewed and discussed this proposed fee increase and has recommended increasing the fee; and

WHEREAS, the most appropriate way to increase said fee is to repeal and replace in its entirety Section 640.020 of the City of Pevely Municipal Code which pertains to the required contents of the applications for licenses for contractors and subcontractors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PEVELY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 640.020 of the City of Pevely, Missouri Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced by the following language:

Section 640.020      Contents of Application

- A. Each application shall state:
1. Name, address, and phone number of the applicant.
  2. General contractor or subcontractor
  3. Evidence of workers' compensation insurance (if applicable).
  4. Evidence of general liability insurance.
  5. Construction contractors who are transient employers shall show proof the employer has been issued a tax clearance and has filed a financial assurance statement.
- B. An application fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) will apply and be in effect from January 1 to December 31. The fee will not be prorated.

Section 2. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinctive, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect January 1, 2021 and after.


