## ORDINANCE NO. 1696

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 702.D. OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER ADOPTING THE OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS, EXPENDITURES AND EXPENSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 AND LEVYING A REAL ESTATE TAX ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 AT THE RATE OF 1.957 MILS ON EACH DOLLAR OF ASSESSED VALUATION, OR THE SUM OF NINETEEN.FIFTYSEVEN (19.57) CENTS ON EACH ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION AND LEVYING A SEPARATE ASSESSMENT DEDICATED TO THE PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP FIRE SERVICES ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 AT THE RATE OF .835 MILS ON EACH DOLLAR OF ASSESSED VALUATION, OR THE SUM OF EIGHT. THREE FIVE (8.35) CENTS ON EACH ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION.

The Council of Plymouth Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania does hereby enact and ordain the following:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 702.D. of the Home Rule Charter, Council does hereby adopt the operating and capital budgets, expenditures and expenses for the Fiscal Year 2024 attached to this Ordinance and such amounts are hereby appropriated from the Fund Equities, revenues and other financing sources available for the year 2024 for the specific purposes set forth in the attached.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 702.D. of the Home Rule Charter, Council does hereby levy a tax on all real property within the Township subject to taxation for the Fiscal Year 2024 at a tax rate for general purposes in the sum of 1.957 mils on each dollar of assessed valuation or the sum of nineteen.fiftyseven (19.57) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation and levying a separate assessment dedicated to the Plymouth Township Fire Services on all property within the Township for the fiscal year 2024 at the rate of .835 mils on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of eight.three five (8.35) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

Any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this Ordinance shall be and Section 3. the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same effects this Ordinance.

Section 4. In accordance with Section 702.D of the Home Rule Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
