

**RESOLUTION**

**ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS ON BETSY BROWN CIRCLE**

On motion of TRUSTEE DIDDEN, seconded by TRUSTEE DORAZIO, the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Chester, New York:

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted on June 5, 2023, the Board adopted parking regulations imposing prohibited parking and standing on a portion of Betsy Brown Circle; and

WHEREAS, since that time, resident complaints have been presented to the Board about the sufficiency of these regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board referred this matter to the Traffic Commission for their consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Commission has recommended that the village’s retained planning consultant study the matter and, in the interim, that new parking regulations be established extending the prohibition of parking and standing on the north side of the street to which the Board concurs. Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Code of the Village of Port Chester, Chapter 319, Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 319-74 (Schedule XIII)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 319-20, the parking or standing of vehicles is prohibited at all times in the following locations:
