

RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS ON BROWER PLACE

On motion of TRUSTEE DIDDEN, seconded by TRUSTEE GRANGENOIS-THOMAS, the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Chester, New York:

WHEREAS, in response to a resident complaint, issue has been raised as to the parking of vehicles at the traffic island on Brower Place; and

WHEREAS, deeming it a matter of public safety, the Traffic Commission recommended parking and standing be prohibited at this location; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Board concurs. Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Code of the Village of Port Chester, Chapter 319, Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 319-74 (Schedule XIII)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 319-20, the parking or standing of vehicles is prohibited at all times in the following locations:
