

**Ordinance 2023-06**

**An Ordinance to Amend the Code of the County of Price by Adding Chapter 403 Peace and Good Order  
Article XV Offenses Against State Laws Subject to Forfeiture**

Be it ordained (enacted) by the Price County Board of Supervisors as follows:

**Section 1.** The Code of the County of Price is hereby amended by adding Article XV Offenses Against State Laws Subject to Forfeiture.

**§ 403-62. Offenses against state laws subject to forfeiture enumerated.**

The following statutes defining offenses against the peace and good order of the state are adopted by reference to define offenses against the peace and good order of the County. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein by reference are intended to be made part of this chapter.

<u>Statute Section</u>	<u>Subject</u>
254.92	Purchase or possession of tobacco products by a person under 18 prohibited
941.10	Negligent handling of burning material
941.12(2) and (3)	Interfering with firefighting
943.01(1)	Damage to property
943.017	Graffiti
943.125	Entry into locked coin box
943.15	Entry onto a construction site or into a locked building, dwelling or room
943.20	Theft (value under \$500)
943.21	Fraud on hotel or restaurant keeper, recreational attraction, taxicab operator, or gas station (value under \$500)
943.37	Alteration of property identification marks
946.41	Resisting or obstructing officer

**§ 403-63. Violations and penalties.**

Anyone causing, creating or maintaining a violation of this article shall be subject to a forfeiture as provided in Chapter 290 of the County Code, together with cost of prosecution.

**Section 2.** Effective date.

This ordinance shall be effective as of date of publication.
