**RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 10**

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A COUNCIL MEMBER  
TO FILL A VACANCY ON THE COUNCIL  
OF THE BOROUGH OF RED HILL**

**WHEREAS**, a vacancy in the office of Council Member of the Borough of Red Hill, County of Montgomery, Pennsylvania has occurred due a resignation; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 901 (a) of the Borough Code provides that the Borough shall fill such vacancy within thirty (30) days by appointing, by resolution, a registered elector of the Borough who has also resided within the Borough continuously for at least one year immediately prior to the date of appointment, to hold such office until the first Monday in January after the first Municipal Election occurring more than sixty (60) days after the vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible person shall be elected to the office for the remainder of the term; and

**WHEREAS**, the next Municipal Election will be held in November of 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council desires to appoint Carly Gebhard to the Red Hill Borough Council to fill said vacancy.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Red Hill, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania that Carley Gebhard a registered elector of the Borough of Red Hill is hereby appointed to the office of Council Member with a term to expire on January 2, 2024.

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that there shall be elected at the next Municipal Election, which shall occur in November 7, 2023, a qualified registered elector of the Borough of Red Hill to hold such office from the first Monday in January, 2024 (i.e., January 2, 2024).

This Resolution shall be effective September 13, 2023.
