

ORDINANCE NO. 745

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SELLERSVILLE, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ARTICLE I (DOG-CAUSED NUISANCES), CHAPTER 48 (ANIMALS) OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SELLERSVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of Sellersville Borough, Bucks County, that the Code of the Borough of Sellersville (the "Code") is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 48-1 of the Code

Section 48-1 of Article I, Chapter 48 of the Code, is hereby amended by deleting its text in its entirety and replacing it with the following: "It shall be unlawful for any person owning or possessing a dog to permit the dog to run at large. 'Run at large' shall mean the presence of a dog at any place within the Borough, except upon the premises of the owner, if it is not on a leash or otherwise under the physical control of a person physically able to control it."

SECTION 2. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability

If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
