In addition to any and all other fees and charges provided by law, the owner of a parcel of land served by the sanitary sewer system of the FISD shall pay an annual sewer rent for the use of such sanitary sewer system, which shall be based upon an annual charge of \$900 for each separate dwelling unit served by the system. Such annual sewer rents shall be paid in semiannual installments of \$450 on the first day of January and June of each year. B. If such sewer rents are not paid within 30 days of the due date, a penalty of 5% shall be paid.
