ORDINANCE NO. 2017-06

**AMENDING CHAPTER 5-61.2(A)(1) TO CLARIFY PROMOTION
ELIGIBILITY IN THE SPRINGFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, a review of Chapter 5-61.2(A)(1) of the Township Code raised questions regarding eligibility for promotions in the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council determined that clarification was necessary to avoid confusion as to eligibility to sit for promotional testing;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Township Council of the Township of Springfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 5-61.2(A) be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

“A. Promotion Eligibility

- (1) A uniformed police officer of this Police Department must serve at least five years with the department as a basic uniformed police officer with at least fifty percent of his or her time as a full time officer before becoming eligible for promotion to the rank of Sergeant.”
