ORDINANCE NO.2018-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SPRINGFIELD,
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
AMENDING CHAPTER 5, SECTION 91 D(1) and (2). OF THE CODE OF SPRINGFIELD
TOWNSHIP CONCERNING EXTRA DUTY ASSIGNMENTS FOR
POLICE OFFICERS AND PAYMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED
INCLUDING TOWNSHIP EQUIPMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Springfield, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 5, Section 91.D is hereby supplemented to and added as follows:

5-91.D.

- (1). Per hour, per officer or any part there of in a Township which is party to Interlocal Services Agreement.....\$60.00
- (2) Police vehicle, per day or part thereof outside Springfield Township which is a party of Interlocal Services Agreement\$ 90.00
- (3) Administrative fee per hour, per officer paid to the Township..... \$10.00

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances heretofore inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. In the event a portion or portions of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such partial invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its final adoption, publication of notice of final passage, and filing with the Township Clerk.
