ORDINANCE NO.2019-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SPRINGFIELD,
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 11 OF THE CODE
OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING
NO STOPPING OR STANDING ZONES ALONG
JACKSONVILLE-JOBSTOWN ROAD (CR 670) FROM
MT. HOLLY-JACKSONVILLE ROAD (CR 628) TO ACCESS
DRIVEWAY TO JACKSONVILLE PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Springfield, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Section 4.1 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Springfield known as the Springfield Township Code is amended to include additions to SCHEDULE IV, as follows:

SCHEDULE IV

STOPPING OR STANDING

In accordance with the provisions of Subsection 11-3.7, no person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets during the time and day designated:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>	<u>TIMEANDDAY</u>
JACKSONVILLE-JOBSTOWN RD (CR 670)	From the intersection of CR 670 and CR 628 east to the access driveway to Jacksonville Park	at any time

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances heretofore inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. In the event a portion or portions of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such partial invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its final adoption, publication of notice

of final passage, and filing with the Township Clerk.
