A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE SULLIVAN COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES

Explanation: This Local Law shall set forth amendments to § A2-9 & § A2-10 of the

Sullivan County Administrative Code to reflect modifications to the Sullivan County Administrative Code regarding Legislative Committees.

Legislative Intent: The Sullivan County Legislature, after consideration, declares that it is

proper to amend the Administrative Code to eliminate references to

Legislative Committees in § A2-9 & § A2-10.

Amendments: The Administrative Code is amended by deleting the current language

contained in § A2-9 & § A2-10 in the entirety and inserting the language

"[Reserved]" in both Sections.

Effective: This Local Law shall become effective as of the date of filing with the

Secretary of State.
