ORDINANCE NO. 9-2016 AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY BOARD FOR VOTEE PARK TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY BOARD AND AMENDING SECTION 2-148 OF ARTICLE XXX OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEANECK BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEANECK THAT ORDINANCE #9-2016 PASS UPON SECOND AND FINAL READING AND THAT THE TOWNSHIP CLERK IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO ADVERTISE THE SAME ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, as a result of site testing in connection with the construction of soccer fields using Green Acre funding which revealed the presence of certain contaminated soils at or below the surface of Votee Park within the Township of Teaneck, the Township Council authorized an Environmental Engineering firm to undertake a further site investigation of Votee Park; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 4256, adopted March 20, 2012, the Township of Teaneck had heretofore establish an Environmental Advisory Board for Votee Park to review the results of the final report and to make recommendations to the Township Council respecting the remediation, in any, of Votee Park, the construction of the soccer fields and the restoration of Votee Park following any required remediation thereof; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary remediation at Votee Park and the soccer fields have been completed; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council wishes to retain the Environmental Advisory Board as an ongoing advisory committee to investigate and make recommendations on environmental remediation issues throughout the Township of Teaneck;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Council, Bergen County, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph "c." of Section 2-148 of Article XXX, "Advisory Boards," of Chapter 2, "Charter/Administrative Code," of the Code of the Township of Teaneck is hereby amended and supplemented, to add thereto Paragraph "c" to read in full as follows:

- "c. An Environmental Advisory Board is hereby created as follows
- (1) Its membership shall consist of a maximum of nine (9) regular members, all of whom shall be residents of Teaneck, who shall be appointed by the Township Council in accordance with the provisions of Rule IX respecting advisory boards of Appendix I of Chapter 2 of the Code of the Township of Teaneck. In addition to its regular members, the Council may designate one of its members as a liaison to the board. In addition the Township Manager, or his designee, may serve as a representative to the Board. The

Council’s liaison and the Manager’s representative, may attend meetings of the board and may participate in all discussions but shall not have a vote.

(2) In accordance with the provisions of Rule IX respecting advisory boards of Appendix I of Chapter 2 of the Code of the Township of Teaneck, the Township Council shall appoint the Chairperson of the board from among its regular members.

(3) The terms of all regular members shall be one (1) year from the date of their appointment unless extended or unless the board is dissolved prior to the expiration of such term.

(4) The board shall have the following duties:

(a) review, analyze and assess test data, test methodology, and findings and conclusions contained in any site investigation report or proposed site remediation plan authorized by the Township Council respecting any location within the Township of Teaneck.

(b) make recommendations to the Township Council respecting additional testing or investigation at any such locations, the remediation of such locations, if any, and the restoration of such locations following any required remediation thereof.”

Section 2. Severability. In any section, sentence, clause or other portion of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or repeal the remainder of this ordinance, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed severable.

Section 3. Inconsistency. In the event of the inconsistency between the provisions of this ordinance and the provisions of any other ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days following passage and publication thereof following adoption as required by law.
