ORIDINANCE AMENDING THE SALARY RANGES FOR THE MAYOR, BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR, CHIEF OF STAFF, DEPARTMENT DIRECTORS, DIRECTOR OF HOUSING & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, COURT DIRECTOR AND PART-TIME MUNICIPAL JUDGES

WHEREAS, the salary ranges for City officials and certain positions are required to be established by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 16-50 was adopted by the Trenton City Council on October 21, 2016, establishing salary ranges for certain positions within the City; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 23-26 was adopted by the Trenton City Council on May 8, 2023, establishing the salary ranges for certain City officials including the Director of Finance which is exempt from this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 23-43 was adopted by the Trenton City Council on August 10, 2023, establishing the salary ranges for certain officials including the Director of Law and the Director of Recreation, Natural Resources, & Culture which are both exempt from this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to amend the salary ranges for the Mayor, Business Administrator, Chief of Staff, Department Directors, Court Director and Part-time Municipal Judges.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the City Council of the City of Trenton, as follows:

- 1. The salary range for:
 - A. The Mayor shall be \$140,000 \$160,000.
 - B. The Business Administrator shall be \$131,884 \$160,000.
 - C. The Chief of Staff shall be \$131,844 \$150,000.
 - D. The Department Directors shall be \$131,844 \$155,000.
 - E. The Director of Housing & Economic Development \$131,844 \$175,000
 - F. The Court Director shall be \$119,716 \$131,000.
 - G. The Part-time Municipal Judges shall be \$59,760 \$75,000.00.

ORDINANCE

- 2. No elected official or appointed official hired after the effective date of said ordinance shall be eligible to receive monetary compensation in excess of the amount set forth above, including any enhanced pay for longevity, or for holding any particular licenses or credentials.
- 3. The Mayor is hereby directed to implement all necessary changes to the personnel policy and payroll practices and methods to continue the pay for each person filling each of the above offices to the amounts fixed herein,
- 4. The Mayor is also directed to make provisions for the publication in the appropriate place on the City of Trenton's website of the total annual salaries actually paid to each of the City's elected and appointed officials or employees whose compensation is not determined by collective bargaining agreements but set either by the City Council or the Mayor.
- 5. The City Council may consider salary increases for certain positions set in this Ordinance annually.
- 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance as required by applicable law.
- 7. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
