**ORDINANCE 2018-10**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16  
“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(c)(1), the City of Union City has the authority to prohibit or restrict general parking; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Union City deems it necessary to revise Chapter 16, Section 4, “Vehicles and Traffic;”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Union City, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey that the Code of the City of Union City is hereby supplemented as follows:

**SECTION ONE**

§16-4.10(d)(1) Bus/Commuter Vehicle stops.

- (1) Parking is hereby permitted in bus/commuter vehicle stops from the hours of 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM., except as follows:
  - (a) Parking shall not be permitted in the bus stops/commuter vehicle stops on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> Streets; and
  - (b) Parking shall not be permitted in bus stops/commuter vehicle stops on Bergenline Avenue from 30<sup>th</sup> Street to 47<sup>th</sup> Street on the West side of the street.

**SECTION TWO:**

**Severability.** If any term or provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, in whole or in part, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION THREE:**

**Repealer.** To the extent that any provision of the Code of the City of Union City is found to conflict with this Ordinance, in whole or in part, this Ordinance shall control.

**SECTION FOUR:**

In order to avoid accidental repeal of existing provisions, the City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are hereby authorized to change any chapter numbers, article numbers and/or section numbers in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between those numbers and the existing Code.

**SECTION FIVE:**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.



7 we allow people to park in the bus stops any time  
8 after --

9 Nine p.m. is it?

10 CITY CLERK: Yes.

11 MAYOR STACK: -- after nine p.m. --

12 CITY CLERK: Or ten p.m.; ten p.m.

13 MAYOR STACK: Ten?

14 CITY CLERK: Yes.

15 MAYOR STACK: -- after 10 p.m. until six  
16 o'clock in the morning.

17 We're probably one of the few if not the  
18 only municipality in New Jersey that allows this,  
19 recognizing that there's a need for parking.

20 We've done this a number of years ago. It  
21 actually creates probably three or four hundred  
22 additional spaces in the City.

23 We're constantly looking for ways to create  
24 more parking. We just recently marked out the  
25 spots in the City over the last summer to this

1 year.

2 This is just another measure that we're  
3 just trying to clean up the Ordinance to make  
4 sure people have that right to do so to park in  
5 the bus stop.

6 Anyone wishing to comment on this Ordinance
