ORDINANCE 2019-1

ORDINANCE AMENDING SALARY ORDINANCE FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-165, the governing body of a municipality shall fix and determine the salaries, wages or compensation to be paid to its officers and employees by way of ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Union City (the "City") is a municipality as defined by Title 40 of the New Jersey Statutes; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the City updates the salaries, wages and compensation of its officers and employees by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City now seeks to again update the salaries, wages and compensation of its officers and employees, and same will be on file in the office of the City Clerk and available for examination during normal office hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Union City, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey that the City's Salary Ordinance is hereby amended and revised as set forth in the attached schedule and will be available for examination during normal office hours in the Office of the City Clerk.

SECTION ONE:

Severability. If any term or provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, in whole or in part, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION TWO:

Repealer. To the extent that any provision of the Code of the City of Union City is found to conflict with this Ordinance, in whole or in part, this Ordinance shall control.

SECTION THREE:

In order to avoid accidental repeal of existing provisions, the City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are hereby authorized to change any chapter numbers, article numbers and/or section numbers in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between those numbers and the existing Code.

SECTION FOUR:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE 2019-2

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4
"ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT"
ARTICLE XIII OF THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF UNION CITY
ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"

WHEREAS, the City has established regulations and fees for off-duty police details; and
WHEREAS, Section 4-77 "Off-Duty details" sets forth the that the Chief of Police Establishes regulations for coordination, control and scheduling of the off-duty details; and

WHEREAS, private parties are able to hire Union City police officers for security and other such duties; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to charge a fee for the private use of the City's Police Officers; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the procedure for the collection of fees would be more efficient if the fees were paid upon scheduling of the detail work; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Union City wishes to amend this Chapter to require that the fees for off duty police details be paid upon scheduling of the service being provided.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Union City, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey do hereby amend the ordinance as follows:

SECTION ONE

Chapter 4 Section 4-77 "Off-duty details" is hereby amended to add the following paragraph:

(E.) All fees for off-duty police details must be paid upon scheduling of the detail.

SECTION TWO:

Severability. If any term or provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal, invalid, or un-

enforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, in whole or in part, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE:

Repealer. To the extent that any provision of the Code of the City of Union City is found to conflict with this Ordinance, in whole or in part, this Ordinance shall control.

SECTION FOUR:

In order to avoid accidental repeal of existing provisions, the City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are hereby authorized to change any chapter numbers, article numbers and/or section numbers in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between those numbers and the existing Code.

SECTION FIVE:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.



ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4
"ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT"
ARTICLE XIII OF THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF UNION CITY ENTITLED
"POLICE DEPARTMENT"

SECTION THREE:

Repealer. To the extent that any provision of the Code of the City of Union City is found to conflict with this Ordinance, in whole or in part, this Ordinance shall control.

SECTION FOUR:

In order to avoid accidental repeal of existing provisions, the City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are hereby authorized to change any chapter numbers, article numbers and/or section numbers in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between those numbers and the existing Code.

SECTION FIVE:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, the City has established regulations and fees for off-duty police details; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-77 "Off-duty details" sets forth the that the Chief of Police Establishes regulations for coordination, control and scheduling of the off-duty details; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Union City wishes to amend Section 4-77 to set forth that the Chief may establish regulations pertaining to off-duty police details, but is not required to do so.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Union City, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey do hereby amend the ordinance as follows:

SECTION ONE

Chapter 4 Section 4-77 Paragraph (A.) "Off-duty details" is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

(A.)The Chief of Police may establish regulations within the Police Department providing for control, coordination, scheduling and approval of off-duty police details which conform to all applicable New Jersey State Attorney General guidelines and other controlling regulations. The Chief may modify such regulations from time to time to remain consistent with prevailing regulations or by other grounds that the Chief believes justify such change.

SECTION TWO:

Severability. If any term or provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, in whole or in part, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms and provisions of this Ordinance.
