ORDINANCE NO. 2019-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 397-23 "RATES" TO UPDATE THE SERVICE AND STORAGE CHARGES TO BE USED BY TOWING OPERATORS WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.49, municipalities may regulate the operators of businesses engaged in removal of motor vehicles, commonly known as towing operators; and

WHEREAS, the City of Union City has adopted ordinances regulating and licensing businesses engaged in towing and storage services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wishes to update the service and storage charges to be used by towing operators operating within the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Union City, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey that Section B of code 397-23 of the "Revised General Ordinances of the City of Union City" entitled "Rates" shall be amended as follows:

SECTION B

Section 397-23, <u>Rates</u> section (B) is hereby amended and replaced in its entirety as follows:

B. No licensee may charge in excess of the following rates for services, including towing, conveying, repairing, servicing or storage of the vehicles:

- All vehicles 5 tons and under: \$125 All vehicles over 5 tons: \$250 per hour with a two-hour minimum charge.
A service charge, as applicable herein, shall be charged if the subject vehicle has been hooked up to tow, but has not left the scene. The above charges are subject to the New Jersey state
tax A towing operator can charge 25% more than the rates set forth in this rates schedule if the City declares a snow emergency

SECTION TWO:

<u>Severability</u>. If any term or provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, in whole or in part, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE:

Repealer. To the extent that any provision of the Code of the City of Union City is found to conflict with this Ordinance, in whole or in part, this Ordinance shall control.

SECTION FOUR:

In order to avoid accidental repeal of existing provisions, the City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are hereby authorized to change any chapter numbers, article numbers and/or section numbers in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between those numbers and the existing Code.

SECTION FIVE:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
