

**BOROUGH OF VERONA**

**ORDINANCE NO. 04-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF VERONA, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE 03 OF 2014, AS CODIFIED AT CHAPTER 215, ARTICLE VII § 215-24 B., AS WELL AS ORDINANCE 5 OF 1980 AS CODIFIED AT CHAPTER 162 § 162-3 I.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 215, Article VII § 215-24 B., of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Verona prohibits alcohol at outside dining areas; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 162 § 162-3 I. of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Verona prohibits the carrying, transporting or consuming of any malt, spirituous, or vinous beverages whatsoever within the limits of Borough parks, or to remain while under the influence of the same; and

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Borough of Verona desires to remove these blanket prohibitions and instead permit the consumption of alcohol as Council may permit from time to time as outlined by resolution of council; and

**BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Council for the Borough of Verona Allegheny, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows

**SECTION I.** Chapter 215, Article VII § 215-24 B. of the codified ordinances of the Borough of Verona is hereby amended to remove the prohibition of alcohol at outside dining areas. Alcohol shall be permitted at any outside dining or socializing area that has secured a permit for outside dining/socializing from the Borough

**SECTION II.** Chapter 162 § 162-3 I. of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Verona to eliminate the prohibition the carrying, transporting or consuming of any malt, spirituous, or vinous beverages whatsoever within the limits of Borough parks. Section 162-3 I shall hereafter read that consumption of alcohol in Borough Parks may be permitted at the discretion of Borough Council via permit, the process for which Council may from time to time establish or amend by Resolution provided that, under no circumstance shall any person be permitted to remain at a Borough Park while under the influence of same.

**SECTION III.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.


**SECTION IV.** If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of Verona Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
