**LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 2021**

**PROPOSED LOCAL LAW OPTING OUT OF ADULT-USE CANNABIS RETAIL DISPENSARIES AND ON-SITE CANNABIS CONSUMPTION SITES**

A local law to opt out of allowing adult-use cannabis retail dispensaries and adult-use on-site cannabis consumption sites to locate within the Village of Waterloo as authorized under Article 4 of the Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act.

**1. Legislative Intent.** It is the intent of the Village of Waterloo to opt out of allowing cannabis retail dispensaries and on-site cannabis consumption sites in the Village of Waterloo that would otherwise be allowed under the New York State Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act.

**2. Authority.** This Local Law is adopted pursuant to New York State Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act § 131, which expressly authorizes the Village Board to adopt a local law requesting the Cannabis Control Board to prohibit the establishment of adult-use retail dispensary licenses and/or on-site consumption licenses within the jurisdiction of the Village of Waterloo. This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum/referendum on petition pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law § 24.

**3. Local Opt-Out.** The Village Board of the Village of Waterloo hereby opts out of allowing cannabis retail dispensaries and on-site cannabis consumption sites from being established and operated within the Village's jurisdiction. In accordance with the New York State Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act § 131(1), the Village requests the Cannabis Control Board to prohibit the establishment of the retail dispensary licenses and on-site consumption licenses contained in Article 4 of the New York State Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act within the jurisdiction of the Village of Waterloo.

**4. Severability.** If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

**5. Permissive Referendum / Referendum on Petition.** This Local Law is subject to a referendum on petition in accordance with New York State Marijuana Regulation and Taxation Act § 131 and the procedure outlined in Municipal Home Rule Law § 24.

**6. Effective Date.** This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
