VILLAGE OF WATERLOO

A LOCAL LAW OF THE YEAR 2023

A local law authorizing the abolishment of the position of Village Justice effective March 31, 2023 and the consolidation of the Village Justice Court with the Town of Waterloo Justice Court.

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Waterloo, New York, as follows:

1. **Legislative Intent:** It is the intent of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Waterloo to abolish the position of Village Justice, effective March 31, 2023, to reflect action taken on November 14, 2022 by resolution of the Village Board pursuant to Section 3-301(2)(a) of the Village Law of the State of New York which provides the authority for the consolidation of the Village Justice Court with the Town of Waterloo Justice Court.

2. Authority: This local law is adopted pursuant to Village Law Section 3-301(2), New York State Constitution, Article VI, Section 17(d).

3. **Reference Removal**: The Village Board of the Village of Waterloo, County of Seneca, is hereby authorized to remove and amend any reference to the terms "Village Justice and "Acting Village Justice" as contained in the current Village Code.

4. Severability: If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

5. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
