INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2024

**A LOCAL LAW OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL, COUNTY OF ORANGE,
AMENDING CHAPTER 233 OF THE TOWN CODE**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose

In connection with the continued utilization and effectiveness of the Town Code of the Town of Wallkill, and in the interest of the protection and promotion of the public health and safety, the Town Board has determined, pursuant to the recommendation of the Town Commissioner of Public Works, that it is necessary to place a vehicle weight restriction on the public highway know as Beverly Road within the Town as set forth herein.

Section 2.

A. The Town of Wallkill Code, Section 233-9 entitled “Certain vehicles prohibited”, shall be amended by adding the following road to the section:

Street	Weight Limitation	Location
Beverly Road	5 Tons	From NYS Route 302 for the entire length of Beverly Road

B. Add the word “tons” after each numerical weight limitation specified in the section.

Section 3. Separability

If any provision of this local law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this local law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill hereby declares that it would have passed this local law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Section 4. Statutory Authority

This local law is enacted in accordance with the powers granted to the Town Board pursuant to the provisions of Article 16 of the New York State Town Law and Article 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, pursuant to which the Town Board has the authority to enact local laws and amend local laws for the purpose of promoting the health, safety or general welfare of the Town of Walkkill and for the protection and enhancement of its physical environment.

Section 5. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
