AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1774, CHAPTER 15, PART 4, SECTION 407 – SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING ZONES ESTABLISHED: PARKING OTHERWISE PROHIBITED, TO ADD 1 HANDICAP PARKING SPACE AT 1200 ALLISON AVENUE AND 1 SPACE AT 36 CENTRAL AVENUE.

WHEREAS, City Council for the City of Washington is desirous of amending Ordinance 1774 Chapter 15 Part 4, Section 407 to add 1 handicap parking space at 1200 Allison Avenue and add 1 handicap space at 36 Central Avenue.

WHEREAS, City Council for the City of Washington deems that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Washington to amend Ordinance NO. 1774 Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 407.
