FROM NORTH TO SOUTH: WALNUT STREET TO THE CENTER LINE OF RAILROAD STREET.
FROM WEST TO EAST: THE CENTER LINE OF FRANKLIN STREET TO THE CENTER OF COLLEGE STREET

THE WASHINGTON BUSINESS DISTRICT AUTHORITY SHALL MAINTAIN A LIST OF PARCELS WITHIN THE SPECIAL SERVICES DISTRICT AND WILL PRESENT AN UPDATED LIST TO THE CITY CLERK ANNUALLY.

WHEREAS, City Council for the City of Washington deems that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Washington to approve **ORDINANCE NO. 1943 BILL NO. 9 of 2020.**

This Ordinance shall become effective upon FINAL PASSAGE and shall be applicable for the year 2020.
