- Section 4: This shall be in full force and effect on and after its approval and passage.
- Section 5: All ordinances and parts or ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

Currently we are charging labor costs equally to both water and sewer at the 50%. This year Sewer is more labor intensive and for more accurate labor cost sewer will be 60% and water 40%; therefore, charged to the budget that way.

The City of Warsaw wastewater collection system consists of \pm /- 22 miles of collection lines. Majority of collection lines are 4" in size with a few that are 21". The City operates 6 lift stations and a SBR Sewer Treatment Plant.

Current sewer rates for Warsaw is \$ 17.86 plus \$5.69 for each 1000 gallons of metered water. Starting January 2024, sewer rates base \$22.51 plus \$6.47 for each 1000 gallons.
