

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 260.010 AND 260.080.A OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, MISSOURI ESTABLISHING EXEMPTIONS FROM THE SMOKE FREE AIR ACT FOR CIGAR BARS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Washington, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 260.010 of the Code of the City of Washington, Missouri is hereby amended by adding thereto the following definition:

CIGAR BAR

A business with a permit to sell alcoholic beverages that generates twenty-five percent (25%) or more of its quarterly gross revenue from the sale of cigars and/or rental of humidor space, has a humidor and air ventilation system on the premises and does not allow minors to enter the smoking area.

SECTION 2: Section 260.080.A of the Code of the City of Washington, Missouri is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

- 5. Cigar bars, provided that smoke does not infiltrate into areas where smoking is otherwise prohibited.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
