

**AN ORDINANCE  
TO AMEND SECTION 147-10, "AUXILIARY POLICE" OF CHAPTER 147, " POLICE  
DEPARTMENT" OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN GENERAL ORDINANCES**

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATERTOWN DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 147-10, "Auxiliary Police" is hereby amended to read and include as follows:

The Chief of Police may establish an auxiliary police organization consisting of volunteer members residing in the City who shall assist members of the Watertown Police Department and perform services under the direction and control of the Chief of Police. Auxiliary police members shall not make arrests or carry firearms. The auxiliary police shall be compensated at a rate to be determined by the Common Council. The Chief of Police shall establish the rules and regulations of the auxiliary police.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force the day after its passage and publication.
