LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 2023, AMENDING CHAPTER 209, § 209-8, OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF WEST HAVERSTRAW, RELATING TO THE RESTORATION OF STREETS AND STREET OPENINGS BY UTILITY COMPANIES AND THEIR CONTRACTORS

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of West Haverstraw:

Section 1: Village Code Chapter 209 (Streets and Sidewalks), at Article I, § 209-8 C. and D., relating to "Restoration and maintenance", shall be amended, and, as amended, shall read as follows:

§ 209-8 Restoration and maintenance.

- C. Any street opening or excavation performed within eight years of a road restoration project by the Village shall require permittee to restore the road from road edge to road edge or curb to curb, except upon application to, and approval by, the Village Board. Restoration may include milling, if reasonably necessary to restore the condition and appearance of the road to that which existed before the street opening or excavation, and shall include resurfacing.
 - As used in this Section 209-8, the term "road restoration project" shall include road projects that have improved or restored a village road, or portion thereof, by means of milling and paving, paving, micro-seal, crack sealing, or equivalent processes.
- D. Any street opening or excavation performed more than eight years after a road restoration project by the Village shall require permittee to restore the road to 1/2 the width of the road, *i.e.*, from edge of road or curb to center line, except upon application to, and approval by, the Village Board. Restoration may include milling, if reasonably necessary to restore the condition and appearance of the road to that which existed before the street opening or excavation, and shall include resurfacing.

Section 2: Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
