

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5, SECTION 1.14 OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE
(GENERAL LICENSING PROCEDURES-FEE SCHEDULE)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST ORANGE, NEW JERSEY that Chapter 5, Section 1.14 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange be and are hereby amended as follows:

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to modify the fines set forth in Chapter 5, Section 1.14 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Orange to be amendable by Resolution such that it is amendable in the future by approval of the Township Council, a necessity in an everchanging socioeconomic climate.

II. CHAPTER 5, SECTION 1.14 SHALL BE AND HEREBY IS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED TO INCORPORATE THE FOLLOWING:

§5-1.14 BE AND HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- The portion entitled “Fee Schedule” which specifies the schedule of fees for permits and licenses not provided for elsewhere in the code shall be repealed and replaced by the following language:

The following is a Schedule of Fees for permits and licenses not provided for elsewhere in this revision. The initial application for permits and licenses pertaining to amusement devices shall be accompanied by a fee as prescribed by Resolution, \$100 per location fee in addition to the fees hereinafter provided.

- ~~a. Automatic amusement games, \$250 per year.~~
- ~~b. Blasting, \$50 per month, \$200 annual.~~
- ~~c. Circulars and handbills, \$20 per person per day.~~
- ~~d. Driving ranges and miniature golf courses, \$200 per year.~~
- ~~e. Junk dealer, \$100 annual.~~
- ~~f. Pawnbroker, \$100 annual.~~
- ~~g. Pool and billiard tables, \$15 per year.~~
- ~~h. Shuffleboard, (not coin operated), \$20 per year.~~
- ~~i. Tank trucks, \$100 per year.~~

III. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

Any Ordinances of the Township which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

IV. SEVERABILITY

If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
