**An Ordinance Amending § A600-1 Referencing Sections 300-5B and 300-5G of the  
Weyauwega Code of Ordinances  
Fee Schedules for the Class B Liquor Licenses for the 2020-2021 License Year**

---

WHEREAS, the Common Council recognizes that Emergency Order 12 and 28 Safer At Home Order specifically requires Bars to cease operations with the exception of carry out services under certain direct restrictions, and

WHEREAS, the Badger Bounce Back initiative intimates continued regulation on tavern operations for an indefinite period of time, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council recognizing the particular economic strain such regulations have put on Class B Liquor Licensed premises, wishes to provide some relief for the 2020-2021 liquor license year;

NOW THEREFORE the Common Council of the City of Weyauwega do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: § A600-A as it references Sections 300-5B of the Weyauwega Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to provide that the fee for Retail "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor Licenses be reduced to \$50.00 for the licensing period of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021; effective with the licensing periods commencing July 1, 2021, and thereafter, said fee shall be \$300.00 per year.

SECTION 2: § A600 as it references Section 300-5G of the Weyauwega Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to provide that the fee for Retail "Class B" Fermented Malt Beverage Licenses be reduced to \$0.00 for the licensing period of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021; effective with the licensing periods commencing July 1, 2021, and thereafter, said fee shall be \$100.00 per year.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage and publication according to law.
