#### Proposal to Amend Chapter 160-11E., Subsections E (4), E (5) and E (6)

§ 160-11. Regulations for M Industrial District. (Condensed)

(4) Front yards. No part of any-building or structure shall-extend nearer than 60 feet to the side line of the street or 85 feet from the center line of the street, whichever requires the greater setback from the street-line. No automobile parking space shall extend closer-to the street line than 20 feet.

<u>Amendment</u>: Front yards. No part of any building or structure shall extend nearer to the street line than 25 feet or nearer the center line of the street than 50 feet, whichever distance requires the greater setback, also in conjunction with proper clearance to nearby utilities (i.e. natural gas & utility/poser lines)

(5) Rear yards. There shall be a rear yard of not less than 35 feet.

<u>Amendment:</u> Rear yards. There shall be a rear yard of not less than 25 feet, except that in the case of through lots the front yard requirement specified in Subsection E(4) above shall be observed on both streets.

(6) Side yards. There shall be two side yards, each having a width of not less than 35 feet.

<u>Amendment:</u> Side yards. There shall be two side yards having a total of not less than 30 feet. The minimum width of any side yard shall not be less than 10 feet.
