ORDINANCE NO. 2017-09**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 191, ENTITLED "TATTOO PARLORS", OF THE
CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: Chapter 191 of the Code of the Borough of Wrightstown is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with this Ordinance.

Section Two:

Section 191-1. The purpose of this Chapter is to implement the provisions of the State Sanitary Code, N.J.S.A. 26:1A-7, et. seq., and the State regulations relating to Body Art Procedures, N.J.A.C. 8:27-1.1, et. seq. This Chapter shall be entitled "Body Art Establishments".

Section 191-2 DEFINITIONS:

The definitions set forth in N.J.A.C. 8:27-1.3 and any amendments thereto are incorporated herein by this reference. Such definitions are supplemented as follows:

- a. Act shall mean the State Sanitary Code, N.J.S.A. 26:1A-7, et. seq., and any amendments thereto.
- b. Health Authority shall mean the Burlington County Board of Health.
- c. Rules shall mean State regulations relating to Body Art Procedures, N.J.A.C. 8:27-1.1, et. seq. and any amendments thereto.

Section 191-3 LICENSE REQUIRED:

No person, firm or corporation shall operate any Body Art Establishment or utilize any premises in the Borough of Wrightstown as or for a Body Art Establishment unless or until such person, firm or corporation has complied with the provisions of the Act and the Rules and has obtained a license or other form of authorization from the Health Authority and the Zoning Officer.

Section 191-4 RENEWALS:

- A. All licenses shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance.
- B. Licensees may renew their licenses prior to expiration by filing a new application with the Health Authority in the manner prescribed in the Rules.

Section 191-6 APPLICATIONS FILED WITH MUNICIPAL CLERK:

A copy of the application for a License filed with the Health Authority shall be filed simultaneously with the Municipal Clerk.

Section 191-7 OPERATION OF BODY ART ESTABLISHMENTS:

All Body Art Establishments shall be operated in accordance with the Act and the Rules.

Section 191-8 INSPECTIONS BY ZONING OFFICER OR HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

- A. The Health Authority and its designees are authorized to conduct random inspections of every Body Art Establishment granted a license under the provisions of this chapter for the purpose of determining whether the provisions of this chapter are being complied with. Such inspections shall be unannounced but shall be made at reasonable times and in a reasonable manner. It shall be unlawful for any licensee or employee of the licensee to fail to allow such inspection officer access to the premises or to hinder such officer in any manner.
- B. The operator shall permit access to all parts of the establishment and all pertinent records required for the inspection shall be made available to the health authority representative for review.

Section Three: Severability. If any sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any persons or circumstances shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, or if by legislative action any sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall lose its force and effect, such judgment or action shall not affect, impair or void the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section Four: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

Section Five: Repealer. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

NOTICE

The Ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Wrightstown, held on October 25, 2017. It will be further considered for final passage after a Public Hearing at the regular meeting to be held on November 8, 2017, at the Borough Hall, 21 Saylor's Pond Road, Wrightstown, New Jersey at 6:30 P.M. at which time and place any persons desiring to be heard upon the same will be given an opportunity to be heard.
