ORDINANCE #2020-04**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 26, STORMWATER COORDINATOR, IN  
CHAPTER 184, ENTITLED STORMWATER MANAGEMENT, OF THE CODE OF  
THE BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WRIGHTSTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Chapter 184 of the Code of the Borough of Wrightstown is hereby amended to include a new Section 26, which is hereby established in and shall become part of Chapter 184, Stormwater Management:

§ 184-26. Stormwater Coordinator.

a. The Municipal Stormwater Coordinator shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Borough Council of the Borough of Wrightstown. The Municipal Stormwater Coordinator shall serve a term of office of one year commencing on January 1 of the year of appointment and ending on December 31 of the year of appointment, or until a successor shall be appointed and qualified.

b. The Municipal Stormwater Coordinator shall the Borough representative required to be designated pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14A-4.9(a)3 who shall be responsible for overall municipal stormwater facilities or municipal environmental matters as allowed in N.J.A.C. 7:14A-4.9(b). The Stormwater Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the Borough's implementation of the stormwater program set forth in this Chapter and the Tier B MS4 NJPDES permit conditions. The Stormwater Coordinator shall coordinate completion, signing, dating and submission of an Annual Report and Certification required by the permit.

Section 2: All Chapters and Sections of the Code of the Borough of Wrightstown unaffected by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: Severability. If any sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, or if by legislative action any sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall lose its force and effect, such judgment or action shall not affect, impair or void the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

Section 5: Repealer. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.
