Collection System Problems

(Separate) Sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) from diversion chambers, manholes and sewage backups into basements are the types of emergency situations which generally occur. On occasion, pump station malfunctions also cause overflows at the station(s) wet well (manhole).

Overflows are generally reported by local residents or others, who either contact the Authority's office directly at 412-279-4941 or by fax 412-278-2001. Additionally, overflows may be reported by the Collier Township Police Department, or Collier Township Road Department (office: 412-429-6811).
