RESOLUTION NO. 07-04

**A RESOLUTION SETTING AND IMPOSING SEWER RENTALS
OR CHARGES FOR THE USE OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OPERATED
BY NEW HANOVER TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY AND FOR THE
TREATMENT OF WASTES DISCHARGES THERETO UPON THE OWNERS
OF IMPROVED PROPERTIES SERVED BY SUCH SEWER SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of New Hanover Township herein before enacted and adopted the New Hanover Township Code of Ordinances, Ordinance No. 97-7, including the adoption of an Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU) Schedule, and imposing sewer rentals or charges for the use of the New Hanover Township Wastewater Treatment System by owners of imposed property, and reaffirming the Rules and Regulations for the collection of such rentals and the means thereof; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 97-7, as amended, provides that the sewer rentals, rates and charges shall remain in full force and effect until revised, amended, increased, decreased or otherwise modified by subsequent action and/or resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of New Hanover; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of New Hanover Township and the New Hanover Township Authority executed a Lease Agreement dated July 17, 2002, which provides, among other things, that the New Hanover Township Authority shall fix, charge and impose appropriate sewer rents and charges for the use of the sewer system upon the owners of each property served and to be served; and,

WHEREAS, the New Hanover Township Authority, based upon a review and evaluation of the costs and expenses associated with the operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, revision, modification and expansion of the New Hanover Township sewage facilities, including, but not limited to, the sewer and wastewater collection, transportation, transmission, conveyance and treatment system, has determined that it is necessary to revise and modify the base sewer rental rate charged per EDU; and,

WHEREAS, in consideration of said financial evaluations, the New Hanover Township Authority desires to set and impose a sewer rental or charge for each Equivalent Dwelling Unit, EDU, at the rate of \$500.00 per annum, payable at the rate of \$125.00 per quarter annum.

NOW THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the New Hanover Township Authority as follow:

1. That the sewer rental rate or charge for domestic sewage for each Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU) shall, effective the first day of January, 2005, be \$500.00 per

annum, payable at the rate of \$125.00 per quarter annum.

2. That the remaining terms and conditions regarding billing, involving, surcharges, reading of meters and the method of collection of such rates shall be and remain consistent with the terms of Ordinance No. 97-7, as amended, and the applicable Ordinances, and Resolutions of New Hanover Township and the New Hanover Township Authority, and the Authority hereby reaffirms the terms, conditions, rules and regulations as therein set forth.

3. That the rate and charge as herein established shall remain in full force and effect until revised, amended, increased, decreased or otherwise modified by subsequent action and resolution of the New Hanover Township Authority.
