#### **Appendix A**

#### **ANIMAL IMPOUNDMENT AND SHELTERING FEE SCHEDULE**

##### **DOGS**

- A. First seizure: impoundment fee of \$10, plus a boarding fee as determined below.
- B. Second seizure against the same dog owner or same dog when occurring within one year of the first seizure: impoundment fee of \$20, plus a boarding fee as determined below.
- C. Third and subsequent seizures against the same dog owner or same dog when occurring within one year of the first seizure: impoundment fee of \$30, plus a boarding fee as determined below.
- D. Boarding fees for any unaltered dog six months of age or older, seized in violation of § 68-8A or § 68-10C, shall be \$10 per night or portion thereof of impoundment.
- E. Boarding fees for any dog younger than six months, or any neutered or spayed dog seized for any violation of this article, shall be \$5 per night or portion thereof of impoundment.
- F. Proof of spaying or neutering shall be determined from the dog's official license. Proof of age of less than six months shall be determined from the rabies certificate or from a veterinarian statement.

##### **CATS**

- A. Any impounded cat which: is "identified," as defined below, is spayed or neutered, and has a current rabies vaccination, and for which authoritative proof of all three of these conditions can be shown, shall be subject to the following fees: impoundment fee of \$3, plus boarding fees of \$1 per night or portion thereof of impoundment.
- B. Any impounded cat which does not meet one or more of the above requirements shall be subject to the following fees: impoundment fee of \$5, plus boarding fees of \$3 per night or portion thereof of impoundment.
- C. "Identified" cats shall include cats which the owner can show proof were: tattooed and registered, ear notched and described, wearing a collar with indelible markings or tag, or other reliable identification as approved by the Animal Control Officer.
- D. Authoritative proof can include statements from veterinarians, animal shelters, breeders or other authority as approved by the Animal Control Officer.

## ONEONTA CODE

### **FERRETS AND OTHER ANIMALS**

Redemption fees will be charged in the amount of an impoundment fee of \$5, plus boarding fees of \$3 per night or portion thereof of impoundment.

### **RABIES VACCINATIONS**

A fee of \$10 will be added to any reclaim fees of any dog or cat that requires a rabies vaccination prior to release.

### **ANIMAL LICENSING FEE SCHEDULE**

- A. As per Agriculture and Markets Law, local license fees are hereby set forth in addition to the New York State license fees.
- B. The annual local license fee for each dog owned or harbored within the City of Oneonta, except those dogs described as purebred or owned by residents 65 years and older, shall be as follows:
  - (1) Spayed or neutered dogs: \$5.
  - (2) Unspayed or unneutered dogs: \$10.
- C. Proof of spaying or neutering required shall be the same as required by New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets.

### **PUREBRED LICENSES**

The annual local fee for each purebred license issued within the City of Oneonta shall be \$25.

### **RESIDENTS 65 YEARS AND OLDER**

For residents aged 65 years and older, the annual local license fees shall be as follows:

- A. Spayed or neutered dogs: \$3.
- B. Unspayed or unneutered dogs: \$10.
