#### **Schedule A Toxic Substances (effective October 1, 1996)**

For purposes of Article I, Dumping, the term "toxic substance" shall include, but not be limited to, the following

- A. Corrosive, reactive, irritating, flammable or explosive substances, including ammunition and components, capable of causing damage to or destruction of human tissues in the concentration presented, including photographic chemicals.
- B. Petroleum products, including distillates or solvents, brake fluid and antifreeze.
- C. Halogenated solvents, acids and alkalis in concentrations capable of human tissue damage or obstruction.
- D. Chlorine, bromine, wood preservatives, heavy metals, pesticides and herbicides in any concentration.
- E. Aerosol products, compressed gases and their containers.
- F. Batteries, light fixtures and bulbs and products containing heavy metals.
- G. Pharmaceutical, medical and biological products and wastes, including blood and blood products and sharps.
