Steel & Aluminum Containers and Foil
- PAPER**  
Cardboard (flattened), Office Paper, Newspaper, Magazines
- PLASTIC**  
Bottles, Tubs, & Jugs Only
- GLASS**  
Bottles & Jars Only
- FOOD & BEVERAGE CARTONS**
- Clean & Empty**  
LEAVE CAPS & LIDS ON

**NO!**

- Do Not Bag Recyclables**
- No Plastic Bags or Product Wrap**  
(Return clean to retailer)
- No Tangles**  
(Hangers, Hoses, Wire, Cords, Ropes or Chains)
- No Food, Liquid, Diapers, Batteries or Needles**
- No Big Items**  
(Electronics, Wood, Propane Tanks, Scrap Metal or Styrofoam - For other options, visit [swalco.org](http://swalco.org) for our online Where Do I Recycle This Guide)
- No Clothing, Textiles or Shoes**

## PRESIDENT'S CORNER

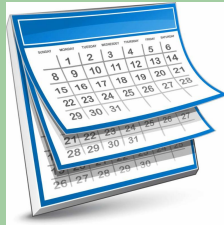
The Solid Waste Agency of Lake County (SWALCO) is an organization whose goals is to provide Lake County residents with programs and infrastructure to economically divert as much materials as possible from landfills. I serve on that Board of Directors and their Executive Committee. We have created a neighborhood programs website that will reflect our local Bannockburn information. We have also developed more detailed recycling guidelines to recycle correctly. China's decision to significantly reduce its imports of mixed paper and plastics and to demand cleaner recyclables has rippled throughout the markets and put a spotlight on contamination. The more contamination the higher the cost to process the material at recycling facilities. In turn, those costs are passed on to households and businesses. This new website content will provide our residents with the detailed knowledge they need about what can and can't be recycled, and in the end reduce the confusion about how to recycle in today's more complicated packaging environment."
