Officer Mike Volling has been promoted to Lieutenant, effective February 1st.

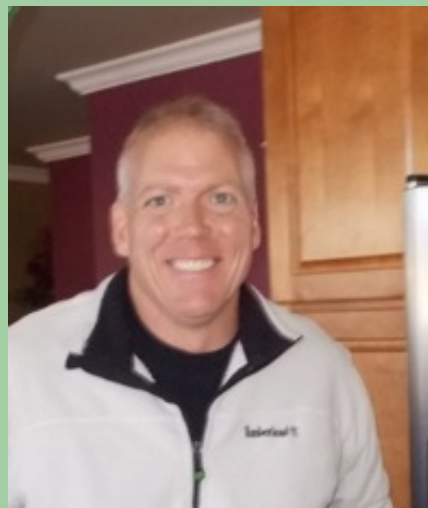
Officer William (Bill) Annen joined the Bannockburn police department as a part time officer in October 2019. He was recently sworn in as a full time officer beginning on February 1st.

## PRESIDENT'S CORNER

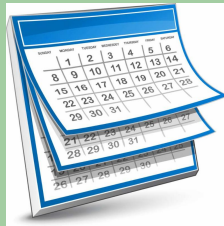
Just a few notes of interest this month.
