As everyone has predicted, this week has seen substantial increases in people being diagnosed with the virus. We have been staying home to try to flatten the infection curve which will give hospitals and healthcare workers time to prepare for serious cases.

- 2. No big and bulky items will be picked up no furniture, mattresses, white goods, electronics or landscape materials..
- 3. If a driver shortage occurs, or possibly a closure of recycling sorting centers, the drivers will pick up both trash and recycling cans with the same truck.

We have also closed the play ground equipment for as long as the "Stay at Home" order is in effect.
