All of your individual election and voting information is located at **VOTER POWER** , on the Lake County Clerk website. When logged in you can track your ballot, find out what's on your ballot, and where to vote. Enter your name, address and birthday, all your voter information will be displayed.

IMPORTANT BALLOT BOX LOCATION INFO FOR BANNOCKBURN RESIDENTS

Submit your completed ballot **NOW**: The closest secure **ballot box** is located at the Juvenile Court building, 24647 N. Milwaukee Ave., Vernon Hills. This court branch is located north of Route 60 on the east side of the street. This ballot box is outside and available 24 hours day.

Early In-person voting begins October 19, 2020 at the West Deerfield Township office, second floor. There will also be a **ballot box** for you to submit your completed ballot. Hours are Monday-Friday 8:30-7:00pm and Saturday/Sunday 9:00-5:00pm.
