### VILLAGE OF BANNOCKBURN - LAKE COUNTY COVID-19 Resurgence Mitigations Effective 12:01am Oct. 31, 2020

The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) has announced **Illinois Region Lake County Resurgence Mitigation** for Lake and McHenry Counties, effective 12:01 a.m. on Sat., Oct. 31. **Lake County Health Department COVID-19 updates**

#### What's impacted:

##### Restaurants

- No indoor dining or bar service
- All outdoor dining closes at 11:00 p.m.
- Outside dining tables should be 6 feet apart
- No standing or congregating indoors or outdoors while waiting for a table or exiting
- Reservations required for each party
- No seating of multiple parties at one table

##### Bars

- No indoor service
- All outside bar service closes at 11:00 p.m.
- All bar patrons should be seated at tables outside
- No ordering, seating, or congregating at bar (bar stools should be removed)
- Tables should be 6 feet apart
- No standing or congregating indoors or outdoors while waiting for a table or exiting
- No dancing or standing indoors

- Reservations required for each party
- No seating of multiple parties at one table

#### Meetings, Social Events, Gatherings

- Limit to lesser of 25 guests or 25 percent of overall room capacity
- No party buses
- Gaming and Casinos close at 11:00 p.m., are limited to 25 percent capacity, and follow mitigations for bars and restaurants, if applicable

These mitigations do not apply to schools or polling places. Residents are encouraged to limit their exposure by voting early, wearing mask, using hand sanitizer, and watching their distance from others while voting.

## FAQs for Residents and Businesses

### **Are drive-thru, take-out or delivery services impacted?**

No. Mitigations do not restrict drive-thru, take-out or delivery options for restaurants.

### **Is outdoor dining permitted?**

Yes, outdoor dining is permitted in accordance with the guidelines. Tables are required to be a minimum of 6' apart. Tents may be used provided two sides of the tent are up.

### **Do limits on the size of gatherings apply to outdoor events?**

Yes. Gatherings are limited to the lesser of 25 guests or 25 percent of overall capacity both indoors and outdoors. **This includes gatherings at home.**

### **Do the mitigation measures impact indoor shopping and services?**

No. **Phase 4 guidelines** remain in effect for retailers, service counters, and professional services.

### **How can I support Bannockburn restaurants during this time?**

Bannockburn restaurants appreciate your carryout or curbside pickup business during this time.

### **Where can I get a COVID-19 test?**

The Lake County Health Department announced free mobile COVID-19 testing in Deerfield, Highwood, Libertyville and Round Lake this next month. **Mobile Testing Sites**

### **Do you have Halloween Safety Reminders?**

The Halloween Trick or Treat Haunted Trail has been cancelled for 2020.
