Memorandum from Town Supervisor – rRopening Town Departments

Mr. Sturm read his memo to all Town of Bethel Employees

As of Monday, June 1, 2020 we will be going back to fully staffed Town offices and we will be opening our doors to the public a week later on June 8th.

As your employer we will continue to monitor the workplace and will be implementing the following guidelines to help keep our work areas safe and to support you:

- Access to all employees: hand sanitizer, sanitizing, wipes, masks and gloves, and Lysol spray.
- Large signs with simple instructions will be placed at the entranceway stating “social distancing must be maintained: and “please wear a mask, and wash your hands often”.
- We will still ask the public to conduct business by email, fax, phone, conference calls, snail mail, or website whenever possible.
- We will provide Sanitizer at the entranceways before entering.
- We have clearly marked the floors in the Town Hall at 6 foot intervals for additional emphasis on Social distancing requirements.

A glass partition will be added to the Town Clerk office for added protection.

Some of things we expect from you, the employees to implement to keep our workplace safe:

- If you feel sick, call into your supervisor, and stay home!
- Maintain the 6' foot Social Distancing.
- Wash your hands often, and for the recommended 20 seconds. (Sing Happy Birthday Day twice)
- If you cannot comply with the 6' foot social distancing you may, but are not required to wear a face mask, or a cloth face covering.
- Be considerate of your co-workers.
- Remember we are here for the public and each other.
