



**Borough of Bellevue

**I. Roll Call**

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation Committee was called to order at 5:00 P.M. by Chairperson Hefley.

In attendance were Councilperson Hefley (Chair), Lenard, Hrynda, DAS Borczyk, Cultural, Library Director Goodman and HRG Representative Gilberti. DPW Supervisor Olczak was absent.

**II. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person) – None.**

**III. Reports:**

**i. Bayne Library Report**

Cultural and Library Director Goodman reported that the carpeting was almost complete. Councilperson Hefley suggested that bids be secured for the painting of the second floor.

**IV. Old Business:**

**i. Pool Concession Stand – Review Options**

After discussion of the Tri-State Bid to operate the Swimming Pool Concession Stand for the 2016 Season, Councilperson Lenard made a Motion to include the subject on the Agenda of the February 9, 2016 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Hrynda.

**ii. Parks Master Plan Update**

Engineer Gilberti briefed the Committee on the progress of the plan. There is a meeting on February 18, 2016 @ 3:30 P.M. to chart the next steps.

**iii. Library Repairs – AIM Loan**

DAS Borczyk informed the Committee that the pediments were to be painted by the DPW during down time in bad weather.

DAS Borczyk noted that letters for Criminal Clearances would be sent to all 2015 Lifeguards within the next two weeks. This would permit clearances to be complete prior to the opening of the swimming pool.

**V. New Business :**

**i. Bellevue 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary – Special Committee**

Councilperson Heffley informed the Committee that event plans should be for the summer of 2017. Discussion was about published book and parade, similar to the 100<sup>th</sup> Celebration.

**ii. Spring Baseball Field Usage**

Schedules were being submitted by CMU and Northgate for baseball field usage beginning in April, 2016. Councilperson Lenard made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the February 9, 2016 Pre-Council Meeting. Councilperson Hrynda seconded the Motion.

Cultural and Library Director Goodman informed the Committee about a resident who wished to donate Bird Feeders and maintain to feed birds. More information was needed for next Committee Meeting.

Councilperson Lenard made a Motion to include a request to advertise for the Pool Manager for the 2016 Season, on the agenda of the February 9, 2016 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Heffley.

The Committee discussed the possibility to have residents help with the baseball field bleachers at Memorial Park. Further information on this resident was needed.

Councilperson Lenard requested DPW to post the “Young Lungs at Play” signs in Bayne Park and assess the re-finishing of the Library front and back door, handicapped ramp and porch railings as possible upcoming projects. It was also noted that increased patrols at the Library should be requested of the Mayor.

**VI. Public Contributions**

Councilperson Saylor met with a group about coordinating an event involving the trails at Memorial Park. He noted that Venture Outdoors and Bike Pittsburgh would be possible groups to get involved.
