I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Department of Public Works Committee was called to order at 5:45 P.M. by Chairperson Lenard.

Gilberti suggested that a site visit be scheduled with the DPW Committee so that a clear understanding of the issues could be attained.

Councilperson Lenard asked about the progress of hiring summer DPW help. DAS Borczyk informed the Committee that the deadline for applications was April 11, 2016.
