I. Roll Call

A Meeting of the Bellevue Borough Department of Public Works Committee was called to order at 5:45 P.M. by Chairperson Lenard.

In attendance were Councilperson Lenard (Chair), Menosky, Saylor, DPW Supervisor Olczak, DAS Borczyk and HRG Engineer-Gilberti.

II. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person)

Carolyn La Quatra, discussed with the Committee the BIGr House Tour to be scheduled for October 29, 2016 from Noon-4 P.M. She asked if the DPW could hang advertising banners and if the Borough Building could be open for restroom usage with appropriate volunteers to man the building.

i. Update - 2016 Paving Plan

Engineer Gilberti informed the Committee that he was awaiting some administrative paperwork from the Contractor (Protech Asphalt). The schedule was looking like completion during the week of August 22, 2016.

DAS Borczyk informed the Committee that CEC was working on re-bidding the contract due to high initial bids.

V. New Business

HRG Engineer Gilberti informed the Committee of options available to partner with Columbia Gas for stormwater work on the S. Jackson/Monroe Ave. areas. Four (4) options were presented. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to include the request for the Borough to approve Option #1 for work and Columbia Gas to perform Option #2 as their contribution to the project as part of the agenda of the Pre-Council Meeting of August 8, 2016. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Menosky.

Councilperson Hrynda informed the Committee about resident complaints about illegal dumping at East Bellevue Station and a broken storm sewer line.

Councilperson Saylor suggested to the Committee that Jersey barriers be priced for installation by the DPW Department at the end of Rheams Avenue. Because of recent gas line work, there is a danger of a serious vehicle accident from the end of that street.

HRG Engineer Gilberti discussed the 2016 Sewer Project, suggesting that smoke testing of the lines be part of the work. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the August 9, 2016 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Menosky.
