



## Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes

### I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 6:35 P.M. by Councilperson Coder.

In attendance were Mayor Cusick, Councilpersons Coder, Saylor, Police Chief Sentner, Fire Marshall Wissner, DAS Borczyk and Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix. Councilperson Senvisky (Chair) and Fire Chief Pritchard were absent.

#### i. Purchase/Lease Police Vehicle

#### ii. Bunker Gear

Fire Marshal Wissner discussed the need for street maps for the Emergency Operations Center and wished to order prints from a digital file.

Councilperson Coder asked if the "No Parking" Ordinance, addressing Saturday parking on Lincoln Avenue, had passed. DAS Borczyk will check the meeting minutes and follow-up with Councilperson Coder.

Councilperson Coder suggested that Bellevue participate in the CONNECT program offering legal assistance for blighted properties. Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix asked that it include a discussion with Northgate School District about tax forgiveness.

Councilperson Coder made a Motion to discuss the Sign Ordinance at the June 14, 2016 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Saylor.
