I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation Committee was called to order at 5:00 P.M. by Chairperson Heffley

In attendance were Councilpersons Heffley, Hrynda, Lenard, DAS Borczyk, HRG Engineer Gilberti and Cultural, Library Director Goodman. DPW Supervisor Olczak was absent.
