



Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes
November 1, 2016

I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue borough Finance Committee was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Councilperson Woshner.

In attendance were Councilpersons Senvisky, Coder, Saylor, Mayor Cusick, DAS Borczyk, Fire Marshal Wissner, Police Chief Sentner, Fire Chief Prichard and Keith Jankowski of Northwest E.M.S. as a guest. Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix was absent.

II. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person) - None.

III. Reports – None.

IV. Old Business:

i. Discussion - North Avenue Traffic Patterns/Flow

Chief Sentner reviewed the possible traffic options for North Avenue. He suggested possible one way traffic. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to discuss the North Avenue Traffic Patterns/Flow at the Pre-Council Meeting on November 9, 2016. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Code.

ii. Discussion – Meter Feeder

Mayor Cusick discussed the lack of software support issues that caused Bellevue Borough to reject the ability to work with Meter Feeder. Chief Sentner informed the Committee that he would consider any changes in the software situation.

V. New Business:

i. Discuss – Air B ‘n B.

Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to place discussion of this issue on the agenda of the Pre-Council Meeting on November 9, 2016. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Senvisky.

iii. Meade Avenue – Possible Permit Parking

The Committee noted that the Solicitor and Code Enforcement should review this matter.

iii. Request from Police Department to acquire old boiler room for the Police Department. Building maintenance project for 2017.

There was discussion about the needs of both the Volunteer Fire Department and the Police Department for the space created by the removal of the Boiler System. Assistant Fire Chief Glen Pritchard noted that it was purposed for training and not a bunking area. Chief Sentner stated that the police department needed 4-5 thousand square feet for operations and they currently had 2,000 feet.

Councilperson Coder discussed the need for planning for this issue and the Code Enforcement Department. Mayor Cusick discussed the Main Street Committee of Grant Saylor, Mr. Driscoll and Sam Post from T&M Hardware as appointed members that would begin the planning process for the business district.

Mayor Cusick informed the Committee that health issues would reflect in an increase in Police Overtime soon. Councilperson Senvisky made a Motion to include discussion of the Police Overtime as part of the Agenda of the November 9, 2016 Pre-Council Meeting Agenda. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Saylor.

Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to discuss the Structure of the Fire Department for efficient management as part of the Agenda of the November 9, 2016 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Coder.
